Supporting South Western Railway to get its cabling back on track

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South Western Railway turned to Neos Networks for ongoing telecoms deployments at stations and along their rail network.

The challenge

Due to the dynamic nature of each site, South Western Railway required a flexible, adaptable and innovative network specialist, providing technical expertise whilst maintaining the high levels of safety, which are of paramount importance in the rail industry. Some tasks involved working within track side areas, and to do so, comprehensive risk assessments and detailed work package plans were required. These needed to be assessed and authorised prior to the commencement of works.
