

Supercharging Zen Internet's core with a 400Gbps fibre upgrade

How Neos Networks delivered greater capacity and resilience across Zen Internet's UK network

Zen Internet is on a mission to make high-quality, full fibre internet available to more homes and businesses across the UK. As the UK's largest B Corp-certified telecoms provider, Zen is also aiming to become the country's leading alternative network (altnet) aggregator.

The upgrade needed to support Zen’s Fibre Hub, a platform launched to aggregate services from the UK’s top altnets – a key step towards becoming the UK’s leading altnet aggregator.

Zen’s broader goal is to support the UK’s growing bandwidth as data centre investment, AI adoption and full fibre rollout accelerate nationwide. That means building capacity and resilience for the future, delivered at the right price.

The solution

Neos Networks delivered a 400Gbps optical link between Manchester and London, a significant upgrade that gives Zen the capacity it needs to grow. Zen also continues to benefit from Neos’s upgraded exchange backhaul services, which are critical to delivering ultrafast, resilient connectivity nationwide.

Why did Neos’s solution stand out?
