- Ultra-low latency: For live football coverage, latency isn't just technical, it's commercial.
 Delays can impact live streams, replays and even betting markets.
- Always-on reliability: With millions of viewers, multiple broadcasters and billions in rights revenue at stake, there's no room for downtime.
- Fast deployment: The new season was approaching. NEP Connect needed to connect every Premier League venue with minimal lead times.

To succeed, NEP needed a partner who understood the demands of live sport and could deliver highperformance fibre connectivity fast.


